About the Course

Delivered onsite, this program offers real-world experience while you complete the CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing), with a pathway to employment in the industry. Through a combination of classroom learning and practical experience, you'll gain the essential skills and knowledge to become a confident and compassionate aged care worker, ready to make a real difference in the lives of older Australians.

Structure

This program is delivered onsite at Killarney Court, Killarney Vale and combines classroom sessions with at least 120 hours of work placement.

Employment Opportunities and Pathways

Potential roles of employment include Care Service Employee, Accommodation Support Worker, Assistant in Nursing, and Personal Care Assistant. Graduates may also pursue higher qualifications such as CHC43015 Certificate IV in Ageing Support or specialised units within CHC33021.

Fees and Funding

This training is subsidised by the NSW Government. To be eligible for funding, you must be an Australian citizen, permanent resident, humanitarian visa holder, or New Zealand citizen; aged 15 years or older; living or working in NSW; and not currently at school. For more information and to check your eligibility, visit ET Australia's website or contact ET Australia directly. Fee exemptions and scholarships are available for eligible students.

Student Support

Each training program is supported by a dedicated Training Officer who is there to help you every step of the way. You'll also have additional access to your Trainer/Assessor outside of classroom hours.
