About the Course

ET Australia offers a flexible training program designed for experienced aged care workers who are ready to advance their careers. You will build leadership, planning, and care coordination skills required for supervisory roles in a growing sector.

This course combines independent study with structured monthly Trainer sessions, ensuring you receive guidance, practical support, and opportunities to complete assessments.

Flexible Learning Structure

Flexible, self-paced learning designed to fit around your work and personal commitments. Our monthly sessions in Gosford (AM or PM options available) provide opportunities to:

- Receive learner guides, assessment plans, and instructions
- Participate in simulations, role plays, and practical assessments
- Review your progress and plan out the next steps with your Trainer

Ongoing support is provided through regular check-ins, workplace visits and online communication.

Workplace-Based Learning Requirements

Assessment activities are completed in your workplace. You will need employer support, access to relevant workplace tasks and clients, and a Workplace Supervisor who can observe your skills and provide feedback.

Your Trainer will work with your Workplace Supervisor to verify your competency in a real work environment.

Employment Opportunities and Pathways

Potential roles of employment include Care Team Leader, Care Supervisor, Assistant in Nursing (AIN), Program Coordinator, and Lifestyle Coordinator. Graduates may also pursue higher Diploma level qualifications.

Fee-Free* Training – Limited Places Available

Limited fee-free places available through NSW Government funding. If fee-free places are filled, eligible students may access subsidised training. Eligibility criteria apply.
