ET Australia Secondary College Scholarships

A scholarship is money set aside that can assist a family in paying school fees. Scholarships are available for eligible Years 7 to 12 students. The application process is simple. The majority of scholarship applications are successful.

Who is Eligible?

To be eligible, an applicant needs to demonstrate financial hardship and taken into consideration will be the students:

- Enthusiasm for school work.
- Consistent attendance and;
- a willingness to learn, combined with a drive to achieve.

Scholarship Conditions

- Scholarships are to remain confidential.
- Scholarships can cover up to 50% of the current school fees but do not cover any other costs.
- Parents/carers are expected to pay the first 50% of the school fees, and the scholarship will cover the remaining amount where the student's effort and attendance levels are deemed satisfactory.
- Scholarship holders are expected to participate fully in school life.
- No family or student may hold more than one scholarship.
- A scholarship student is not eligible to receive a further sibling discount.
